NDIS Business Connect aims to work collaboratively to improve the quality of services and the safety of service environments to assist in ensuring people with disability have access to appropriate quality support services.

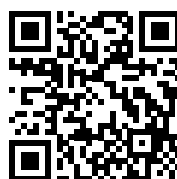
